### Vehicle Decal Distribution

All residents must have an up-to-date decal for each car in their unit. In order to obtain a decal; residents must fill out a Vehicle Decal Information Form. These forms can be printed by going on the Covered Bridge Website or by simply going to the office and obtaining one there. Either way; they must come to the office with their filled in forms; Registration and License; and if they are renters – a copy of their lease.

All forms MUST be filled out COMPLETELY before Decals will be handed out.

Information on these forms includes, Name, Address, Email, Court. For each Vehicle – the Year, Make, Model, License Number, Plate Number, and State, along with their signature.

If the resident is a renter; the expiration date of their lease which will be written on the decal. No decals will be handed out to renters unless their lease is up to date. The Unit Owners are responsible to ensure leases are properly renewed.

If there is ANY change in status of a resident the office MUST be notified so that changes can be made to their files and, if necessary, a new decal and form will be released.

Decals will be distributed at the Clubhouse Mondays & Wednesdays between 8:30 and 11:30 AM and Fridays between 1:30 and 3:30 PM

### MOTORCYCLES





Motorcycles with engines larger than 150cc are NOT PERMITTED

Failure to comply will result in referral to the fining committee.

### VENDOR PARKING

Your hired vendor or contractor is permitted to park in your space or guest spaces only. No vendor or contractor has permission to park in another resident's space or to park in any court space overnight.

No parking is allowed in court centers, thereby blocking any owners' vehicles, or next to the mailboxes. Management has been authorized to tow vehicles not in compliance.

## PETS

No animals or pets of any kind shall be kept in any unit nor on the property of Covered Bridge Condominium without BOARD APPROVAL.

PETS MUST BE REGISTERED at the office and must meet the criteria listed in the Pet Resolution document. Any unregistered pet found on the property will be subject to IMMEDIATE removal.

When outdoors, PETS must always be on a leash. Leashes may not be longer than 6 feet. PETS are not to be left outside unattended


